Franklin County is seeking a reliable and professional **Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Driver** to safely operate county vehicles and transport materials, equipment, and/or personnel. **The Restriction Code only allowed is Code 52.** This position plays a vital role in supporting county operations and requires a strong commitment to safety, communication, and teamwork.

- Perform pre-trip, in-transit, and post-trip inspections in compliance with DOT regulations
- Safely load and unload materials using proper restraints and handling procedures

- Conduct routine vehicle maintenance checks; report issues promptly
